Eiktunet is arranged like a small rural settlement from the 19th century. The view of Mjøsa is fantastic, and the open air museum is one of Gjøvik's most popular hiking destinations. Here you can explore cotter's farms, small ponds and traditional summer mountain farms. Try your luck at fishing - there are carp fish in the ponds. And if you dare, you can join the guide on a tour around the Svartåsen farmyard. Here you will hear about the murder at Svartåsen and other local tales. The cozy Eiktunet Café offers dinner and delicious cakes.
